National Young Performer Awards 2017

The 41st year of the NYPA was an event that was packed full with talented young artists showcasing their talent, once again, in Palmerston North. The Troupe/Group section creates such a high energy start to the Competition with amazing levels of skill, energy and enthusiasm. The Finals Concert was eagerly anticipated and thoroughly enjoyed by the crowd, who were welcomed by the Mayor of Palmerston North, Grant Smith and MC lain Lees-Galloway, MP for Palmerston North. President Deanna Watson also addressed the audience. The Concert started with the medals presentation process, recognizing and valuing each Nominee, as well as the awarding of the Potential prizes and the Audience Choice Awards. The winning Troupe from Friday's competition performed, as well as guest appearances by Modern Adjudicators Renee Schuda & Bryan Anthony. The addition of a Social Media resource in Kelsey Andrew, added another dimension to the NYPA and allowed an additional 7000 people from around NZ to feel part of the weekends Events and to watch the Final presentations!! Palmerston North Dance Assn and Manawatu Performing Arts maintained the high level of organisation for the Final Awards concert, as well as front of house for the weekend. The smooth running of all aspects of the Awards was a credit to them and their Volunteers, who worked in Art Form teams with the PACANZ Board in Art

Great ticket sales resulted in the competitors performing in front of large groups of enthusiastic supporters at both the Speirs Centre, The Globe Theatre and at the Regent on Broadway.

Preparations are well underway for another great weekend in 2018, which will see the 4 Soloist Art Forms joined by the Troupe/Group competitors.

AGM Guidelines:

In order to simplify the process to prepare the annual report and audit and take the deadline pressure off the auditor, the following timeline will be followed:

- AGM matters for discussion must be tabled (received by PACANZ Office) by Wednesday 18 April 2018.
- The 2017 Statement of Accounts will be mailed or emailed to all member societies 30 days prior to the AGM. The final audited accounts and annual report will be presented at the AGM. These will be posted to societies not attending.
- Societies unable to attend may send a proxy voting form which is due at the PACANZ office by 18 April, 2018. The
 Proxy form has been sent to Societies electronically with this mailing




