The Awards weekend was packed full with talented young artists showcasing their talent in Palmerston North for the first time. The Finals Concert was eagerly anticipated and thoroughly enjoyed by the crowd, who were welcomed by the Palmerston North MP, Ian Lees-Galloway.

The Concert started with the medals presentation process, which ensured that each Nominee was recognised and valued as well as the awarding of the Potential prizes.

Palmerston North Dance Assn and Manawatu Performing Arts maintained the high level of previous host Societies, of organisation for the Final Awards concert, as well as front of house for the weekend. The smooth running of all aspects of the Awards was a credit to them and their Volunteers, who worked in Art Form teams with the PACANZ Board. Record ticket sales resulted in the competitors performing in front of large groups of enthusiastic supporters at both the Speirs Centre and at the Regent on Broadway.

With Ballet and Tap both performing all preliminary and semi-finals at the Regent Theatre, timing was quite tight and we really appreciated all the Nominees and their teachers and supporters, meeting the programme deadlines that were set. The backstage team met the challenge of the repeated lifting and laying of the ballet floor, which was a credit to them and certainly appreciated by the Competitors.

The PACANZ Board and the host Societies will be reviewing the 2014 Awards in preparation for another great weekend in 2015.

AGM Guidelines:

In order to simplify the process to prepare the annual report and audit and take the deadline pressure off the auditor, the following timeline will be followed:

- AGM matters for discussion must be tabled (received by PACANZ Office) by Friday 17 April 2015 two weeks prior to the AGM
- The 2014 Statement of Accounts will be mailed or emailed to all member societies 30 days prior to the AGM. The final audited accounts and annual report will be presented at the AGM. This will be posted to societies not attending.
- Societies unable to attend may send a proxy voting form which is due at the PACANZ office by 2 April, 2015. The Proxy form has been sent to Societies electronically with this mailing
- Societies may request a proxy form by emailing Nikki Cunningham at admin@pacanz.co.nz


I am planning to spend time with family over the Xmas break, but with today's technology I am only a phone call or E-mail away if you need me.
