Lucinda Dunn

Lucinda Dunn received her early training in Sydney with Janece Graham and Tanya Pearson before going on to win a Prix de Lausanne scholarship to study at The Royal Ballet School, London. While in London she also performed with Birmingham Royal Ballet and in 1991 Lucinda joined The Australian Ballet and was promoted to principal artist in 2002. In 2015, Lucinda won an Australian Dance Award for *Outstanding Performance by a Female Dancer* for the performance in The Australian Ballet's *Manon*.

As Australia's longest serving ballerina, Lucinda announced her retirement in 2014 and received a Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM), for her service or the performing arts through ballet. Lucinda was appointed as the Artistic Director of the Tanya Pearson Classical Coaching Academy and the Sydney Youth Ballet.

In early 2016, Lucinda attended the Prix de Lausanne ballet competition in Switzerland as one of the members of the jury.

Christian Tátchev

Christian Tátchev trained at the National School of Choreography in Sofia, Bulgaria. He began his professional career at age 16, dancing his first leading roles shortly after and reaching the rank of Principal Artist in 2000. He has danced all major classical roles, as well as works by celebrated choreographers of modern times. Christian has worked with The Sofia Opera and Ballet and the Bulgarian contemporary dance company Ballet Arabesque, as well as with the South African ballet companies PACT Ballet, Cape Town City Ballet and The South African Ballet Theatre (SABT). Christian joined Queensland Ballet in 2008 after participating in the Company's International Gala. He was appointed the Company's Ballet Master in January 2012 after retiring from the stage in September 2011. He took up the position of Director of Training in 2013 and was named Academy Director in 2016. Since his departure from stage, Christian has performed with the Company in a number of productions as a Character Artist.

Tellina Lee

Tellina Lee is an international creative artist that was born and raised in Newcastle, Australia. Born with dance and music in her blood, she started tap dancing at 3, followed by every other style soon thereafter. As well as dance, Tellina is an accomplished actress, singer, V/O artist, choreographer, artistic director and producer. She completed the LGTDA syllabus under the instruction of her amazing tap teacher Donna Michalitsis School of Dance, is a fully qualified tap teacher of the LGTDA syllabus & from 16 years old has been teaching tap dance and putting students through their exams.

She has performed in an abundance of professional musicals, in both USA and Australia and she also travels internationally to teach workshops, choreograph routines, and judge international competitions.

Tellina is the creator and choreographer of "Tap That" and is excited to use her passions and visions to bring tap to another medium incorporating film, videos and the live stage.

Dale Pengelly

Dale's passion for Tap Dancing began at the age of 9 when watching his Sister at Irish dance and thinking he could do better and started shuffling away and it continues to this day. He has successfully sat up to Bronze Star level in Tap Exams in the FATD Syllabus (Highest in Syllabus). Dale has been a leading light in the Australian and International Theatre, spanning the past three decades. He has performed extensively throughout the world in some of the biggest shows in Musical Theatre history. In Between his Musical Theatre Performances Dale has taught Tap and Choreographed for numerous solo dancers competing in the Australian Competitions Scene for various dance studios throughout Sydney, and Brisbane.

Most recently Dale has performed as Don Lockwood in Singin In the Rain.
